The Town Board of the Town of Sumpter, Sauk County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.15(2), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

The Town Board of the Town of Sumpter, by this ordinance, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and by a roll call vote by a majority of the town board present and voting, provides the authority for the town to designate town highways as class "B" highways in the town as follows:

- A. The following town highways in the Town of Sumpter are designated class "B" highways subject to the weight limits set forth in s. 348.16(2), Wis. Stats., unless increased by town ordinance: Old Bluff Trail from US Highway 12 south, to the Town of Prairie du Sac line.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall erect signs as required under s. 349.16(2), Wis. stats., on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways, in violation of the above-noted weight limits, without a written permit issued by the Town Board of the Town of Sumpter. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 348.21, Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on September 20, 2007.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s.60.80, Wis. stats.
