

An ordinance to regulate water traffic, boating and water sports upon the waters of Lake Wisconsin and prescribing penalties for violation thereof.

The town board of the town of Sumpter, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Intent. The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resource.

Section 2. Applicability and enforcement. The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Lake Wisconsin within the jurisdiction of the town of Sumpter in Sauk County. The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the officers of the State of Wisconsin having authority.

Section 3. State Boating and Water Safety Laws Adopted. The statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to water traffic, boats, boating and related water activities and safety in the following enumerated sections of the Wisconsin Statutes, exclusive of any provisions therein relating to the penalties to be imposed or the punishment for violation of said statutes, are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this ordinance. 30.66(2) Speed Restrictions Fixed Limits In addition to complying with sub. (1), no person may operate a motorboat at a speed in excess of the posted notice as established by regulatory markers.

Section 4. Definitions in this ordinance: "Slow-no-wake" means the slowest possible speed so as to maintain steerage.\

Section 5. Restricted Areas. This is to certify by ordinance pursuant to 30.77(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes in the interest of public safety, the Town of Sumpter, Sauk County, Wisconsin has authorized the placement of 6 Slow-no-Wake buoys in Lake Wisconsin, starting from the lot line between Steve Hannah and Doug Jones property 150 feet from shore at a compass reading of 148 degrees. The buoys will be placed in a 50 degree line to the Lake Wisconsin Boat Club between piers numbered 52 and 53. These buoys will intersect with the existing buoys along the property of C.C. Waffenschmidt and leased by the Lake Wisconsin Boat Club, in section 19, T10-11N-R7E Town of Merrimac. The buoys will be placed in section 24, T10N-R6E Town of Sumpter, in the Bay known as Grubers Grove, the area of Slow-no-wake.

The placement and maintenance will be done by the adjoining property owners and the Lake Wisconsin Boat Club.

Section 6. Penalties. 30.80(1) Penalties. Any person violating any provision of ss. 30.50 to 30.80 for which a penalty is not provided under subs. (2) to (6) shall forfeit not more than \$50 for the first offense and shall forfeit not more than \$100 upon conviction of the same offense a 2nd or subsequent time within one year.
