RESOLUTION No. 2017-2

AUTHORIZING THE SAUK COUNTY HUMANE SOCIETY TO SELL DOG LICENSES ON  
BEHALF OF THE TOWN OF SUMPTER

WHEREAS, the Sauk County Humane Society provides animal shelter and humane officer duties within the County of Sauk; and,

WHEREAS, dogs within the county are currently unlicensed, it is expected that if the Sauk County Humane Society sells dog licenses at the Animal Shelter it could increase revenue to the Town of Sumpter, and thereby defray the cost of operating the Animal Shelter while increasing the number of licensed dogs, thus contributing to the health, safety and welfare of the community; and


WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the Town of Sumpter to authorize the sale of dog licenses at the Animal Shelter by the Sauk County Humane Society; and,

Now, therefore, be it resolved, by the Town of Sumpter Board, Sauk County, Wisconsin:


That the Sauk County Humane Society is hereby authorized to sell dog licenses as prescribed by Sauk Co. Code chapter 27 and Wisconsin Statutes chapter 174; and with the understanding that such authority shall cease at such time as the Sauk County Humane Society is no longer the provider of animal shelter services to Sauk County; and with the further understanding that such authority may be terminated by the Town of Sumpter at any time.


The Sauk County Humane Society shall collect the fees listed on the Town of Sumpter fee schedule. The Sauk County Humane Society shall retain the fees set by Sauk County Ordinance and make the appropriate payment to the Sauk County Clerk. Fees in excess of the Sauk County fees and all late payment fees shall be paid to the Town of Sumpter treasurer.
