Ordinance Establishing Split Shifts for Election Officials

STATE OF WISCONSIN

Town of Sumpter

Sauk County

The Town Board of the Town of Sumpter, Sauk County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 7.30 (!), Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Sumpter, Sauk County, Wisconsin, by this ordinance, adopted by a majority of the Town Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders as follows:

- A. There shall be the option of split shifts for election workers on all election days.
- B. The town board shall allow the clerk for each election, to appoint one additional election inspector to serve between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. at the polling place in the Town of Sumpter. Each additional election inspector shall serve as a greeter to answer questions and to direct electors to the proper locations for registration and voting and shall be available to substitute for other election officials who must leave the room during the voting process.

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s.s. 60.80, Wis. Stats as adopted this 13 day of February 2012.
