

## ORDINANCE TO APPOINT CLERK AND TREASURER

Ordinance No. \_\_\_\_\_

The Town Board of the Town of Sumpter, Sauk County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 60.30(1e)(a), the offices of the Town Clerk and Town Treasurer shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the Town Board.

The terms of the offices for the appointed positions shall be set by the Town Board, but may not exceed 3 years per Wis. Stat. § 60.30(1e)(c). The Town Board may re-appoint the officers for additional terms. However, removal by the Town Board during a given term of office may only be for a "cause" as defined under Wis. Stat. § 17.001 and required by Wis. Stat. § 60.30(1e)(f).

This Ordinance is subject to approval by the Town Electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board to be held on November 4, 2014. The referendum questions shall be:


"Shall the person holding the office of Town Clerk in the Town of Sumpter be appointed by the Town Board?"

"Shall the person holding the office of Town Treasurer in the Town of Sumpter be appointed by the Town Board?"

The salary of the appointed positions shall be set by the Town Board and may not be reduced during the term of office.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its Town Board passage, notice after passage per Wis. Stat. § 60.80 and also its referendum approval by the Town Electors as required by Wis. Stat. § 60.30(1e)(b).


